HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

In the early 1960's, three St. Louis area specialty contractor associations, independent of one another, each came simultaneously to the same conclusion that they had no voice in labor negotiations. All three of the associations were employers of the basic crafts i.e. laborers, operating engineers, teamsters, etc. These three associations and their respective presidents in 1966 were: The Greater St. Louis Paving Contractors Association (Herbert Bangert, Busy Bee Materials), the Associated Sewer Contractors (Edwin C. Ryder, Jr., J & S Sewer Construction Company), and the St. Louis Earth Movers Association (Eugene Glosier, Glosier Construction Company).

These three associations decided to form a master organization to negotiate labor contracts as a single, multiple-employer group. As a result, in 1966 the three associations formed SITE Improvement Association (SITE) and retained the firm of A.J. Ahner and Associates, Labor Relations Consultants, to administer the affairs of the newly formed association, and to handle labor negotiations and problems.

The name SITE Improvement Association was selected because the primary activity of the specialty contractors consisted of improving the job site for residential, commercial, industrial and highway construction.

The first president of SITE and continuing to serve as president until 1971 was Mr. Robert Hampton (Busy Bee Materials). Elected as SITE's first Vice-President was Norvell Morice (Nor-Vel Construction Company). Serving as the first secretary was Mr. Jack Grutsch (Maplewood Construction Company).

In 1967, membership in SITE was expanded to include associate members; those companies who provide supplies or services to the contractor. A year later, a fourth specialty association, the Concrete Contractors Association of St. Louis & Vicinity, joined the original three groups that founded SITE Improvement Association. In 1994, a fifth contractors group, the Landscaping Division, was recognized. And, in 2008, two more divisions were created, the Highway/Bridge and Specialty; thus, bringing the number of SITE contractor divisions to its current seven, plus the Associates.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

One of the primary reasons for SITE's creation was to give subcontractors and specialty contractors a voice in labor negotiations. Since its inception, SITE has negotiated more than 100 separate contracts of various lengths with the Laborers (Locals 42, 53-no longer in existence, 110, 660 and 840) Operating Engineers-Local 513, Cement Masons-Local 527 and Teamsters-Local 682.

But the association's labor efforts don't stop just with negotiations. SITE also represents membership in disputes with the various construction trades over rules and jurisdictional issues. During its history, SITE Improvement Association has gained the respect of the labor leaders and their organizations and developed a reputation of fairness in dealing with them that continues to this day.

To keep membership informed, SITE began its first monthly publication, SITE News in 1968. This publication continues to provide articles on governmental issues, legislative topics and industry changes that may affect member contractors and associates.

In January 1969, Mr. David Birenbaum, an employee of A.J. Ahner and Associates, was chosen by SITE's Board of Directors as their new administrator. Mr. Birenbaum changed the firm's name to David Birenbaum and Associates and specialized in association management work. It also employed a young man, Jay Schulteheinrich, who would later play an integral role in SITE's development.

SITE Improvement Association is one of the founding fathers of the Council of Construction Employers (CCE) created in 1970. CCE serves as a counterpart to the St. Louis Building and Construction Trades Council. In hopes of addressing jurisdictional problems among the various crafts and to promote productivity, members of the Building and Construction Trades Council and CCE formed an organization called PRIDE (Productivity & Responsibility Increase Development & Employment) in 1972. These associations continued to involve themselves in labor negotiations but began expanding their activities to other areas of mutual concern. While PRIDE has changed its name to the St. Louis Construction Cooperative, its mission has not altered.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

(cont.)

When the need arose in SITE to support efforts to secure public support for funding construction projects, provide for training new employees, sponsoring educational seminars for both the employer and employees and more; SITE started an industry fund known as the SITE Advancement Foundation (SAF) in 1973.

In 1978, SITE's by-laws were changed to add Associate Members to SITE's Board of Directors. The first two associate members were Richard Bussen (Bussen Quarries) and Richard Thompson (Silver Eagle Construction Products). In 1991, a third associate member was added to SITE's Board of Directors; Ken Mudd (Ken Mudd Hauling). In 2008, Peggy McGrath became the first woman to serve on the Association's Board of Directors in the 41 years of SITE's history. That same year, Ms. Brenda Mainer became the first woman to be elected by the associate members to be on SITE's Board of Directors.

SITE's first golf tournament was held in 1981 at Paddock Golf Club (now known as Florissant Golf Course) in north St. Louis County. In those early years, the after-golf dinner was held at Ron Schaeffer's place across the creek from the golf course. The popularity of the golf tournament required membership to find a new location to accommodate ever increasing numbers, so in 1999, the tournament was moved to Norwood Hills Country Club, where it remains to this day; one of the longest running construction industry golf tournaments in the area.

SITE reached a milestone in 1988 under the presidency of Mr. Bob Morice (Nor-Vel Construction Company) when the association opened its own office and employed its own staff. The board of directors appointed Mr. Jay Schulteheinrich (former employee of David Birenbaum & Associates) as its first independent executive director.

At its 25th anniversary, SITE Improvement Association began the practice of recognizing an outstanding member for guidance and leadership of SITE by creating the President's Award. The first recipient was Mr. Joe Barbagallo-Barbagallo Grading & Excavating. Eight other individual members have since been so honored; Ron

Schaefer-Schaefer-Meyer Grading Division, Inc., Ken Karsten-Karsten Equipment Co., Bob Morice-Nor-Vel Construction, Ray Daub-Kirkwood Excavating, Mark Bussen-Bussen Quarries, Joe Hoette-Hoette Concrete, Mike Jerome-Bi State Utilities Co., Charlie Bollmeier-C.E. Bollmeier Company, Joe Leritz-Leritz Busy Bee Paving, and Frank Marchesi Sr.-Bi-State Utilities Co. The President's Award is the highest recognition the association bestows on a member.

Safety on the job site and off has always been a mainstay of SITE. In 1993, it published a safety manual, an employee safety handbook and contracted services with a mobile education van to provide job site safety training to members. SITE revised its Accident Prevention Manual and Employee Safety Handbook in 1996. The Business Roundtable in 1997 presented SITE its Construction Industry Cost Effective Award for its safety manual and employee safety handbook. The Employee Safety Handbook was translated from English to Spanish. Several years ago, SITE established on behalf of some of its members, a working partnership with OSHA, designed to foster improved safety standards on job sites.

Providing a legislative voice has always been important to SITE's membership. The association has and continues to achieve successes in passing bills that help not just SITE, but the entire construction industry;

- 1995 "Construction Payment" Bill was approved; allowing interest and attorney fees to be paid when payment provisions of a construction contract are being ignored.
- 2001, a revised One-Call Utility Locator Bill was passed. SITE was a leader and strong supporter in establishing the Missouri One Call System, Inc. This is a non-profit single-point notification center that accepts calls from any person excavating in the State of Missouri. The law mandates all owners of underground utilities to become members of the One Call System and requires utilities to locate their lines at the jobsite.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

- 2002, House Bill 1403, Retainage Guidelines passed enabling subcontractors who finish their portion early in a job, before the whole project is completed, to receive payments on satisfactorily completed work.
- In 2006, a Work Zone Safety Bill was approved imposing increased fines and other actions against drivers who fail to obey speed limits and other restrictions in work zones. SITE has always been an industry leader in promoting safer work zones in highway construction areas.
- 2013 a bill establishing in law the Workers' Compensation Premium Adjustment program. This measure alone has saved the state's contractors millions of dollars in workers' compensation costs.
- 2014 Senate Bill 529 capped retainage of publicly funded projects at 5% and expedited retainage release back to contractors. This helped contractors on public works projects with cash flow needs.

Continuing to expand its activities in the legislative arena, SITE's Political Action Committee (SITEPAC) was formed in 1987. This committee continues to support various construction related bond issues and construction minded candidates. SITE PAC has and continues to support candidates who in turn, help the construction industry. In November 2007, Missouri Governor Matt Blunt spoke at SITE membership meeting. It was the first time a sitting governor had addressed SITE membership.

In May 2001, SITE Advancement Foundation (SITE Improvement Association's industry fund) awarded its first scholarships (four at \$1,000). Charles Bollmeier (C. E. Bollmeier Co.) served as the Scholarship Committee Chairman. Since its inception, the Foundation has awarded more than a quarter of a million dollars in scholarship to 139 recipients from 50+ companies. The recipients were sons/stepsons or daughters/stepdaughters of employees of SITE member companies. SITE now awards six \$5,000 scholarships to deserving students to further their education.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Early in 2003, SITE's Board of Directors approved a newly formed networking program for young executives within SITE's member companies called the Young Executives of SITE (YES). Terry Daub (Kirkwood Excavating) and Erik Thompson (Silver Eagle Construction Products) were appointed to serve as co-chairs of YES. One of the group's first activities was to send Care Packages to servicemen and women who were stationed in Iraq and Afghanistan.

SITE networking opportunities have always been one of the cornerstones of the association. The first SITE Christmas Party was held on December 5, 1966. SITE's members started a tradition in 1992 of bringing toys to the Christmas Party. Over the years, more than 4,000 toys have been distributed to less fortunate children in the St. Louis area. In 2018, the tradition was amended, instead of toys, members bought diapers and other essential care items for newborns and toddlers.

On September 9, 2006, SITE celebrated its 40th Anniversary Bash on the Eads Bridge. Approximately 400 members and guests, including legislators and dignitaries, attended the event.

In addition to the annual golf tournaments, one activity that many SITE members fondly recall are the barge parties. These parties took place in 1982, 1988, 1989, 1990-2, 1994, 2007 and 2016.

In 2013, The Young Executives of SITE decided to switch their annual fundraising event from a golf tournament, to a clay bird shoot at Black Hawk Valley Hunting Preserve. The idea was to tap into a "different" market of SITE members and what a success it was! The first shoot sold out in just 3 weeks! The YES group tripled their fundraising profits in just one event, which allowed them to add additional leadership development opportunities for YES members.

In December 2014, SITE purchased a building in St. Charles County near the Page Ave. Extension and Highway 94. The building is approximately 4,200 square feet with a training room for safety training and seminars. Staff moved into the new quarters in February 2015.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

The end of 2015 also brought an end to the tenure of Mr. SITE in many people's view, Jay Schulteheinrich. After 39 of total service to the association, the last 28 as its first and only Executive Director, Jay Retired. Schulteheinrich accomplished much while at SITE; negotiating contracts with labor unions, helping pass favorable pieces of legislation for contractors and setting a solid foundation for SITE to build upon in the future. Schulteheinrich began a two-year advisory role to SITE January 2016. The Board of Trustees named Terry Briggs, SITE's Governmental Relations Director as the new Executive Director. Briggs started with SITE in 2001.

The year 2016 marked the Golden Anniversary (50 years) of the SITE Improvement Association. Membership and staff held a variety of events to commemorate the anniversary. Perhaps none was bigger than the Party at the Ballpark, Busch Stadium. Nearly 400 SITE members, current and past, along with their guests and other invited dignitaries, enjoyed cocktails on the infield, tours of the stadium, dinner and awards presentation honoring SITE members, including 14 companies who have maintained association membership for all 50 years.

The party at the ballpark was not the only "party" held that Anniversary year. Nearly 300 guests cruised the Mississippi River in the ever popular "Barge Party." The 2016 event was the seventh barge party hosted by SITE over the years.

Thanks to voters approving an additional \$900 million in bonding authority, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) continued providing SITE members numerous bid opportunities in the near and long-term future. MSD's Project Clear is a 23 year program to upgrade the sewer system in St. Louis City and County. When Project Clear ends, \$4.7 billion in work is expected to be awarded.

In 2016, SITE renewed for another five years, the SITE - OSHA Partnership. This voluntary program assists both contractors and OSHA to improve job site safety. Contractors can learn of safety techniques used across the country and at the same time demonstrate to OSHA their commitment to on-job safety training.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

In 2017, a new program was started by SITE; the *Investment in Infrastructure Expo*. Unlike other conferences, the Expo showcases future projects that contractors can bid on. The presenters include local county highway directors, MoDOT, and MSD to name a few of the many presenters who annually attend. Nearly 350 participants attended the first Expo and more have attended each succeeding event. After presentations, attendees browse the exhibit hall where there is equipment and suppliers showcase their merchandise. SITE continues holding the Expo

At the close of 2017, SITE again made history. Jennifer Bouquet, President of J & J Boring, Inc. was elected president of the association; becoming the first woman to hold the office. The association continued its involvement in statewide transportation issues, helping place a fuel tax increase on the ballot in 2018. SITE took a leadership role in the subsequent campaign and though voters rejected the proposal, SITE solidified its position as a major influence in transportation funding for the state.

The association continued its involvement in statewide transportation issues, helping place a fuel tax increase on the ballot in 2018. SITE took a leadership role in the subsequent campaign and though voters rejected the proposal, SITE solidified its position as a major influence in transportation funding for the state. As SITE continues to gain new members, SITE outgrew Schniethorsts venue for the annual Christmas Party. The Board approved to move the Christmas Party to Bogey Hills Country Club.

2019 had a few firsts for the organization. SITE created the first of its kind, Construction Leadership Certificate. The certificate was issued jointly with Washington University's School of Leadership and Technology and SITE. Members are taught leadership techniques and advocacy services thru SITE to result in a well-trained construction industry professional.

Also in 2019, the Young Executives of SITE decided to use fundraising money to rehab a dilapidated park in Berkeley. The group raised over \$30,000 at the annual Christmas Party for park equipment and swings.

HISTORY OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

SITE started off 2020 honoring Joe Leritz (Leritz Contracting, Inc./Busy Bee Paving, Inc.) with the coveted President's Award at its January General Membership meeting. Joe became the tenth recipient of the Award. In the spring of 2020, the world fell victim to the COVID-19 Pandemic. A virus that stopped the world. SITE lobbied to keep construction work essential, and fortunately for contractors and suppliers and the organization, construction work continued. During the pandemic, SITE canceled most of its events. Terry Briggs retired at the end of 2020 and SITE's Board appointed Jeremy Bennett as SITE's third Executive Director in 55 years.

In 2021, the association turned 55 years old. A wonderful milestone to celebrate. The 2021 legislative session was very active and productive as a flurry of bills passed through both chambers. Senate Bill 262, a construction industry effort to increase the states gas tax was passed. Championed by Senator Dave Schatz and Representative Becky Ruth, MoDOT is now capable of generating over \$500 million dollars for road and bridge construction. SITE sold out its golf tournament at Norwood Hills CC and its 55th anniversary party at Sky Wars Firework Competition located at Innsbrook Resort. Frank Marchesi Sr. was honored with the President's Award at SITE's Holiday Happy Hour in December, making him the 10th recipient of the award.

In 2022, SITE hired an additional team member, Burnea Lester, to cultivate more inclusive relationships among community leaders, contractors, office personnel, and field workers. Ms. Lester jumpstarted SITE's social media pages on Facebook, LinkedIn and Pinterest. With her assistance, the newly formed Diversity and Inclusion Task Force accomplished a successful "minority guide to construction" town hall and a well-attended MBE/DBE mixer event. Team members Leah Behlmann and Jeremy Bennett were recognized for their 10 years of service to the organization.

In January of 2023, SITE's Board of Directors, for the first time in its history, elected a board member from the Landscaping Division

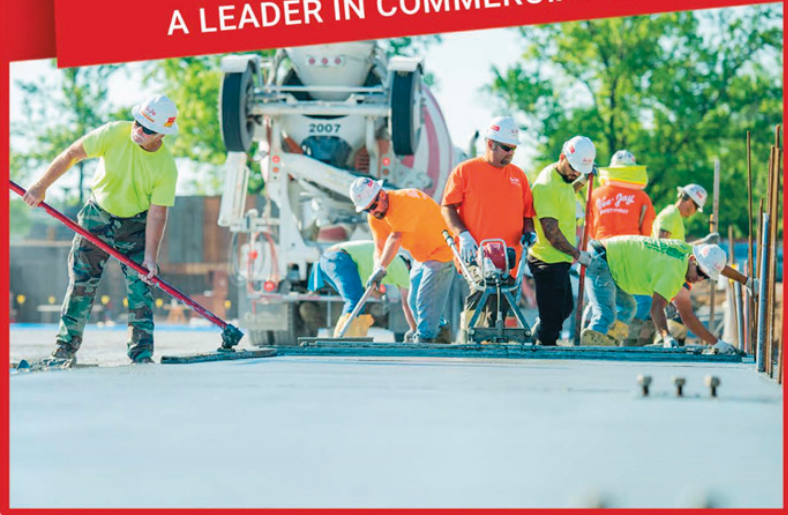

(Steve Roden, Roden's Landscaping) to be President of the organization. In the spring, SITE worked with legislators to pass the 2.8 Billion Dollar expansion of I-70, making it one of the largest investments in infrastructure in the state's history. The expansion includes the addition of a third lane from Wentzville to Kansas City.

Thanks to its members and staff, SITE remains one of the largest and oldest independently operated construction contractor associations in the Midwest. SITE stands ready to assist contractor and associate members with any need!

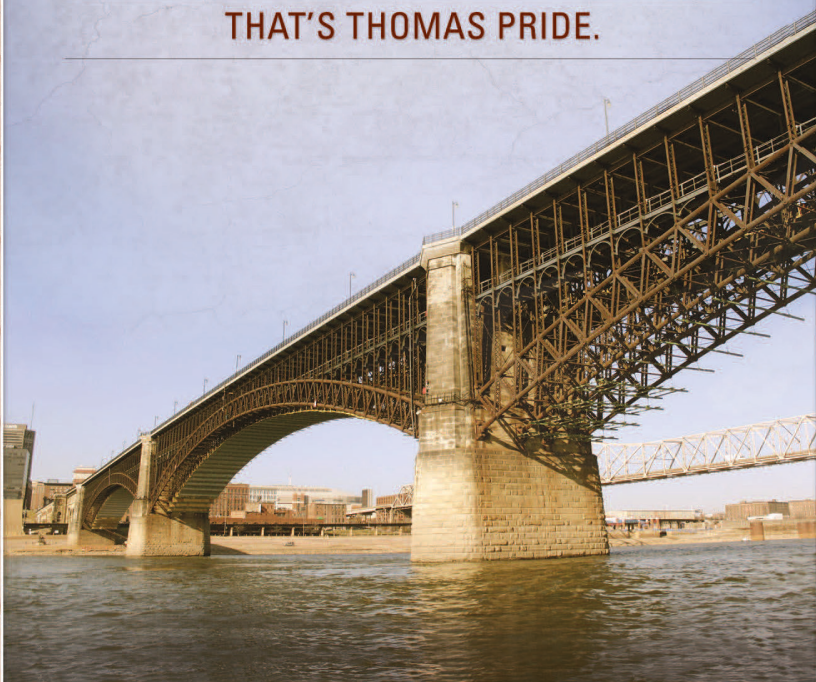

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

Article I Location of Office

Section 1. The principal office of SITE Improvement Association shall be located in the metropolitan area of St. Louis, Missouri.

Section 2. The Association may have offices at such other place or places, either within or outside the State of Missouri, as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time.

Section 3. The Association shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Missouri a registered office and a registered agent at such office, as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time.

Article II Membership

Section 1. There shall be two (2) classes of membership:

- (a) Contractor
- (b) Associate

Section 2. There shall be seven (7) Divisions of Contractor membership:

Concrete Division
Earthmoving Division
Landscaping Division
Asphalt Paving Division
Sewer/Utility Division
Highway/Bridge Division
Specialty Division

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

(a) The Concrete Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform concrete construction such as flatwork, foundation, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, cast-in-place retaining walls, box culverts, etc. for the construction industry.

(b) The Earthmoving Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform earthmoving, grading, digging of basements, backfilling, etc. for residential, commercial, and heavy and highway construction.

(c) The Landscaping Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform landscaping work such as seeding, sodding, tree planting, construction of modular block walls, installation of irrigation systems and the maintenance of grass, trees and shrubs.

(d) The Asphalt Paving Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform asphalt construction, such as parking lots, driveways, tennis courts, pedestrian and bicycling paths or tracks, municipal street overlay, etc.

(e) The Sewer/Utility Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform the installation and repairs of sanitary and storm water lines, water mains and water service lines and the maintenance of such lines.

(f) The Highway/Bridge Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform actual highway, street and road construction including slab tear out and replacement work, and/or bridge construction including structural and box.

(g) The Specialty Division shall consist of those contractors who primarily perform work not described in Article 2, Section (a-f) and are primarily hired to perform a specialized task for general or subcontractors.

Section 3. A member of the Association may be a voting member of only one Division. Any contractor performing work characteristic of more than one of the Divisions must designate the Division in which the contractor performs the majority of work. Such designation shall be chosen at the time annual dues are paid.

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Section 4. The Associate membership in SITE Improvement Association shall be available to companies not performing work as a contractor member as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Section 5. Procedures for admission of a member:

- (a) A candidate for membership must be nominated by a member in good standing.
- (b) A candidate for membership must complete and submit a membership application along with payment of appropriate membership dues.
- (c) A candidate for membership may be approved or denied by the Board of Directors, with or without reason or conditions.

Section 6. Expulsion or Suspension of Membership shall be upon the following conditions:

- (a) Not less than fifteen (15) days prior written notice of the expulsion or suspension and the reasons therefore;
- (b) An opportunity for the member to be heard, orally or in writing (to be determined by the Board of Directors) not less than five (5) days before the effective date of the expulsion or suspension by the Board of Directors;
- (c) The Board of Directors shall consider all the relevant facts and circumstances;
- (d) Written notice must be given by first class or certified mail sent to the last address of the member as shown on SITE's records; and
- (e) Any proceeding challenging the expulsion or suspension including a proceeding in which defective notice is alleged, must be commenced within one year after the effective date of the expulsion or the suspension.

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Article III Meeting of Members

Section 1. Regular meetings of the members of SITE Improvement Association shall be held as scheduled by the President unless cancelled or changed by the Board of Directors, for the purpose of transacting such business as may come before the meeting. The Board shall designate one of the regular meetings to serve as the Annual Meeting, as required by RSMo. 355.231. The Annual Meeting shall be conducted by the President or by the Vice- President in the President's absence.

Section 2. Special meetings may be called at any time by the President or in the absence or disability of the President by the Vice-President or a majority of the Board of Directors. Each call for a special meeting shall state the time, day, place and purpose of such meeting. Each member shall be given no fewer than ten days notice of special meeting, or if notice is mailed by other than first-class, registered or electronic mail thirty days notice. Such notice shall not be given more than sixty days before meeting date. No business shall be transacted at any special meeting other than that included in the purpose stated in the call.

Section 3. At any meeting of the general membership of SITE Improvement Association, twenty percent (20%) of the members being present in person shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business. At any meeting of the membership of a Division, a majority of the voting members of such Division shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business.

Section 4. Whenever all persons entitled to vote at any meeting of the membership of the Association or any Division thereof, and not by

proxy, consent either by writing on the records of the meeting, or filed with the Secretary/Treasurer, or by presence at such meeting together with oral consent entered on the minutes, or by taking part in the deliberations at such meeting without objection, the doings of such meeting shall be as valid as if it had at a meeting regularly called and noticed, and at such meeting any business may be transacted which is not excepted from a written consent or to the consideration of which no objection for want of notice is made at the time. If any meeting of the membership or any Division thereof be irregular for want of notice, or of such consent, provided a quorum was present at such meeting the proceedings of said meeting may be ratified and approved and rendered valid, and the irregularity or defect therein waived, by a writing signed by a two-thirds majority of persons having a right to vote at such meetings.

Section 5. Organization

The President or in his absence, the Vice-President, or in the absence of both, a Chairman chosen by the members present, shall preside at each meeting of the general membership and shall act as Chairman thereof. The Secretary/Treasurer, or in his absence, an individual member appointed by the President, shall act as Secretary/Treasurer at all such meetings.

Section 6. Adjournment

If at any meeting of the members a quorum shall fail to attend at the time and place for which said meeting was called or if the business of such meeting shall not be completed, the members present in person may adjourn the meeting from day to day or from time to time until a quorum shall attend or the business thereof shall be completed. Notice as to date, time and location of new meeting shall be announced at time of Adjournment.

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Article IV Directors

Section 1. Powers

The corporate powers, business and property of SITE Improvement Association shall be exercised, conducted and controlled by the Board of Directors. However, the Associate Directors shall not vote on labor contracts, issues pertaining to labor relations, or the election of Taft-Hartley Trustees or Trust Fund matters.

Section 2. Election and Term of Office

(a) The Board of Directors shall consist of sixteen (16) directors of which fourteen (14) shall be Contractor Members and two (2) shall be Associate Members.

(b) Each Contractor Director shall hold office for a term of two (2) years. The fourteen Contractor Directors shall consist of two (2) contractors from each Division, whose terms shall be staggered so that each year the term of office of one member from each of the Division shall expire. During the month of September a letter shall be sent to each contractor having paid full annual dues within each Division seeking nominees for the Board of Directors. Within fifteen days following such letter a ballot listing such nominees shall be mailed to each contractor having paid full annual dues within such Division. Voting shall be completed within fifteen (15) days after ballot has been mailed. If a tie exists, another ballot shall be mailed. Such ballot shall only list the nominees that have tied receiving the highest votes. If a tie exists after the second ballot, the Board of Directors shall break the tie. Each Contractor Director who has served three consecutive elected terms (six years) shall be ineligible to run for the Board the following year. However, if no nominees are realized from a Division, such position becomes an “open” seat and a director who is ineligible, having served three consecutive elected terms (six years) is now eligible to assume the position for the two year term.

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

(c) Each Associate Director shall be elected for a two (2) year term. One Associate Director shall be elected annually. During the month of September a Nominating Committee consisting of the associate member on the Board whose term is not expiring, plus the current President and Immediate past President, shall meet and compile a ballot of associate nominees to be presented for a vote. Within fifteen days following selection of nominees a ballot listing such nominees shall be mailed to each associate having paid full annual dues. Voting shall be completed within fifteen (15) days after ballot has been mailed. If a tie exists, another ballot shall be mailed. Such ballot shall only list the nominees that have tied receiving the highest votes. If a tie exists after the second ballot, the Board of Directors shall break the tie. Each Associate Director who has served two consecutive terms (four years) shall be ineligible to run for the Board the following year. The Associate Director shall not hold the office of President, Vice-President or Secretary/Treasurer.

(d) Any Director missing two regular Board of Directors' meetings, without a valid excuse as defined below, per calendar year, excluding the Fall Board of Directors' meeting shall be contacted by the remaining Director from within that Division regarding his/her absences. Furthermore, if three of the regular Board meetings per calendar year are missed by any Director without a valid excuse as defined below, such position shall be considered open. Such position shall be filled by a member from within such Division where the vacancy has occurred; selected in accordance with Article IV Section 3 and such individual will serve the remainder of such term. A valid excuse shall be limited to the following: weather; accident; illness or death in the immediate family; or SITE Improvement Association related business.

(e) The terms of office for the newly elected Director shall commence on the January 1st in the year following the election. The directors shall receive no compensation for their service.

(f) If a contractor has an ownership interest in or is an affiliate of two (2) or more companies that are members of the

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Association, a maximum of two (2) individuals from such companies shall, at the same time, serve on the Board of Directors, and only if each individual represents a different company and Division of Contractor membership. For purposes of this Section, the term “affiliate refers to a situation where a company is owned by one (1) or more of the contractor’s immediate family member(s) or their spouses.

(g) Each Board member will be allowed, annually, to attend one (1) Board meeting virtually, which will not count as an unexcused absence providing the Board Member gave written notice of his/her physical absence at said Board meeting no less than 15 days in advance to the Executive Director. Any Board member wishing to attend virtually, who did not give proper notice as described above, may attend virtually, engage in conversation, and participate in Board votes. However, without proper notice as described above, Board members will be marked with an unexcused absence.

Section 3. Vacancies

In case of vacancy, the remaining Director of the Division or the Associate Membership, as the case may be; together with the President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer shall nominate a Director to be approved by a majority of the Board of Directors, who shall serve the remaining term.

If no individual comes forward to assume an open directorship position from within a Division, then thirty days after the opening occurs, the President may appoint, subject to the approval by the Board, an individual from among any of the other contractor divisions. This individual shall be considered a “director at large” and shall serve the remainder of the term. Following the completion of the term, the position shall revert back to the Division to fill such position. However, if position remains unfilled, a “director at large” may again be appointed through the procedure previously stated. A “director at large” shall have the same powers and privileges as a director.

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Section 4. Place of Meetings

Meetings of the Board of Directors of SITE Improvement Association shall be held at such place or manner as indicated by notice issued by the President.

Section 5. Special Meetings

Special meetings of the Board of Directors of SITE Improvement Association for any purpose or purposes shall be called by the President or by written request to the President of majority of the Directors. Such request shall state the purpose or purposes of the proposed meeting.

Section 6. Notice of Special Meetings

The Secretary/Treasurer of the Association shall give notice of all special and regular meetings of the Directors by delivering to each Director a written or printed notice of such meetings, by mail, with postage prepaid; by telegraph; by telephone; by any wire or wireless communication such as electronic mail; or by messenger delivery to each Director so that in the ordinary course of the methods of delivery it would reach the Director on the day prior to the meeting. The business transacted at all special meetings shall be confined to the subjects stated in the notice and matters germane thereto. Business transacted at regular meeting shall be transacted on such subjects as may be the pleasure of the Board of Directors.

Section 7. Meetings Held by Consent

Whenever the Directors consent, either by a writing on the records of the meeting or filed with the Secretary/Treasurer or by presence at such meeting together with an oral consent entered on the minutes, or by taking part in the deliberations of said meeting without objection, the doings at such meeting shall be as valid as if held at a regularly called and noticed meeting and at such meeting any business may be transacted which is not excepted from the written consent or to the consideration of which no objection or want of notice is made at the

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

time. If any meetings of the Directors be irregular for want of notice or for such consent, provided a quorum was present at said meeting, the proceedings of said meeting may be ratified and approved and rendered valid and the irregularity or defect therein waived, by a writing signed by all persons having the right to vote at such meeting. Whenever any notice is required to be given to any Director under any provisions of the Bylaws, a waiver thereof in writing, signed by the person entitled to said notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent thereto.

Section 8. Quorum/Voting at Board of Directors Meetings

A majority of the Contractor Members of the Board of Directors, providing at least five of the Contractor Divisions are represented, at a meeting duly assembled, shall necessarily constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the act of the majority of all Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors. Each director is entitled to one vote.

Section 9. Annual Meeting

There shall be an annual meeting of the Board of Directors in December of each year. The meeting shall include the current Board of Directors and the newly elected Board of Directors. At the December meeting the newly elected Board of Directors shall elect a President, Vice-President and Secretary/Treasurer (no two of whom may be from the same Division) at the annual meeting. The voting procedure for election of officers shall be as follows: Each Board member who will be serving on the Board in the following year shall be entitled to one (1) vote. The first officer to be elected shall be the President. Nominations of officers shall be made in writing (by email; fax or letter); by at least two of the current members of the Board of Directors; and submitted to the Board of Directors in care of the corporate offices no less than five days prior to the Annual meeting. Only current Board members may nominate. If there are no

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

nominations, the current Executive Committee will select a candidate to fill the position. If there is nominated only one candidate, the vote may be by acclamation. Voting shall be by secret written ballot, with the name of his/her choice for the office of President. An impartial observer will tabulate and announce the results of the ballot. If no one individual receives a simple majority of the votes cast, the top two individuals receiving the highest number of votes shall have a run off. If a tie occurs between the two individuals, balloting will continue until one candidate receives a simple majority. The offices of Vice-President and Secretary/Treasurer shall be filled in the same manner and in that order. Only those Directors present at the Annual Meeting shall be permitted to vote. The terms of all officers shall be one year.

The President may not serve for more than three consecutive years.

Section 10. Adjournment

If at any meeting of the Board a quorum shall fail to attend, the majority of the Directors present at that time and place appointed for such meeting may adjourn the meeting from time to time.

Section 11. Organization

The President, or in his absence the Vice-President, or in the absence of both, a Chairman pro tem, chosen by the Directors, shall preside at such a meeting of Directors and shall act as Chairman thereof. The Secretary/Treasurer, or in his absence the Assistant Secretary/Treasurer, or in the absence of both, a Secretary pro tem chosen by the Directors, shall act as Secretary of all the meetings of the Directors.

Section 12. Rules and Regulations

The Board of Directors of SITE Improvement Association shall supervise all officers, agents and factors and see that their duties are properly performed. The Board may adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of their meetings, the guidance of officers and the

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

management of the affairs of the Association as they deem proper, not inconsistent with law or the by-laws of the Association and may from time to time determine the order of business of their meetings.

Section 13. Minutes and Statements

The Board of Directors shall cause to be kept a complete record of their meetings and of the acts and the proceedings of the members.

Section 14. Powers of the Board

In addition to the power and authority conferred upon them by law, the Board of Directors of SITE Improvement Association may exercise all such powers of the Association and of any trust or organization connected with said Association and do all such lawful acts and things as are not prohibited or limited by these bylaws, and which are not required or directed to be exercised or done by the

membership and by their consent and authority first specifically given in evidence in writing. By way of illustration and not limitation, the Board shall have the powers:

- To adopt programs for the benefit of the industry, including, but not limited to, those pertaining to employment relations, industrial practices, public relations, and legislation.
- To retain personnel to assist the Board in fulfilling its functions and obtain necessary facilities and accommodations.
- To negotiate contracts with labor unions on behalf of any contractor, whether or not a member of the Association, who shall assign his bargaining rights to SITE Improvement Association.
- To delegate any powers of the Board to the decision of the majority of the officers as per Article V.

Article V

Officers

Section 1. Executive Officers

BY-LAWS

OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

Executive officers of this organization shall be a President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer, all of whom shall be chosen by the Board of Directors. The President, Vice-President and Secretary/Treasurer shall be chosen from among the Directors. The Executive Officers shall serve to form an Executive Committee, upon which a majority shall act. The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer and immediate past-president. The Executive Committee shall meet as necessary. The purpose and authority of the Executive Committee shall be to advise and direct the SITE Improvement staff as to issues arising between Board Meetings; the approval of expenditures within the budgetary guidelines established by the board; however the Executive Committee shall not have the authority to change, amend or adopt rules; regulations or policy (including personnel issues), all of which shall be reserved powers of the Board of Directors. The immediate past President shall serve as an ex-officio member, but shall receive no vote in Executive Committee actions.

Section 2. Subordinate Officers and Employees

The Board of Directors of SITE Improvement Association may appoint such other officers, agents and factors as it may deem necessary, who shall have such authority and shall perform such duties as from time to time may be prescribed by the Board.

Section 3. The President

The President shall preside at all meetings of the membership and at all meetings of the Directors at which he is present. He shall see that all orders and resolutions of the members and of the Board of Directors are carried into effect, subject, however, to the right of the Board, by resolution, to delegate, any specific powers other than those which may be by statute conferred exclusively upon the President to any other office, Director or agent of the Association. He, or the Vice-President, shall, on behalf of the Association and is authorized by the Board, to execute all deeds, notes, bonds, mortgages, contracts

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

and other instruments in writing and with a Secretary/Treasurer or Assistant Secretary/Treasurer, he or the Vice-President shall sign and issue any documents as may be necessary by the Association. The President has the authority to appoint the chairman or co-chairman of the various committees of SITE Improvement Association. Such appointment(s) shall be approved by a simple majority vote at a meeting of the Directors in which a quorum is present

Section 4. Vice-President

The Vice-President shall, during the absence of the President to any meeting in which he customarily maintains chairmanship or in the case of inability of the President to act, be vested with the powers and shall perform the duties of President. The Vice-President shall also perform such other duties and exercise such other powers as may from time to time be imposed upon or vested in him by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Secretary/Treasurer

The Secretary/Treasurer shall attend all meetings of the membership and of the Board of Directors and standing committees. He shall act as the Clerk or Secretary thereof and shall keep a record of all proceedings at such meetings in minute books kept for that purpose. He shall keep in a safe place the corporate seal and is authorized to affix same of all instruments requiring the corporate seal. He shall have charge of the corporate records. He shall give or cause to be given proper notice of all meetings. He shall have custody of the corporate funds and securities and shall keep full and accurate accounts of receipts and disbursements in the books belonging to the corporation and shall deposit all monies and other valuable effects in the name and to the credit of the corporation in such depositories as may be designated by the Board of Directors. He shall disburse the funds of the corporation in the manner and for the purpose ordered by the Board of directors, taking proper vouchers for all such disbursement, and shall render to the Board of Directors, whenever

BY-LAWS OF SITE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (cont.)

they require, and account of all his transactions as Secretary/Treasurer and the financial condition of the corporation.

Section 6. Delegation of Powers

In case of the continued absence or inability to act of any officer of SITE Improvement Association during his term of office, or for any other reason which the Board may deem sufficient, the Board may delegate all or any part of the powers or duties of any such officer to any other officer or to any Director or agent of the Association for the time being.

Article VI Agents and Attorneys

The Board of Directors may appoint such agents, attorneys, attorneys-in-fact of the Association, as it may deem proper. The Board may authorize such agents, attorneys or attorneys-in-fact to represent it for it and in its name, place and stead, and for its use and benefit to

transact any and all business which said Association is authorized to transact.

Article VII Seal

The Association shall have a corporate seal, a facsimile of which is affixed hereto and made part of this document.

Article VIII Equality Clause

It is the Association's policy that it shall not restrict or limit any principal or employee of a site contractor or associate member from

participating in the activities of the Association because of that individual's race, color, gender, religion, national origin, age, or handicap. The Association does not discriminate, nor does it condone, any discrimination in the workplace, on the job site, in management, or otherwise, in any Association sponsored activity. Any reference within these by-laws to male gender shall be understood to include female gender.

Article IX Indemnification of Directors, Officers & Employees

Every person who is or who has been a Director, Officer or Employee of SITE Improvement Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any action, suit or proceeding in which he is made a party, or with which he may be threatened, by reason of or growing out of or in relation to his being or having been a Director, Officer or Employee of this Association. The term "expenses" includes amounts paid in satisfaction of judgment or in settlement, other than amounts to be paid by the Association itself. The Association shall not, however, indemnify any Director, Officer or Employee in relation to matters as to which he shall be adjudged liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duties as such Director, Officer or Employee. The Association shall not indemnify any Director, Officer or Employee in case of settlement unless such settlement shall be approved by a majority of Directors of the Association then in office other than those involved in the disputed matter (regardless of whether or not such majority constitutes a quorum), or if there are not at least two Directors then in office other than those involved, by a majority of a committee (selected by the Board of Directors) of two or more members of the Association who are not Directors or Officers involved, as being in the interests of the Association that such settlements be made. The foregoing right of indemnification shall not

be exclusive but shall be in addition to any other rights and remedies to which such Directors, Officers or Employees shall be entitled as a matter of law. The indemnification provided herein shall not be considered exclusive of any other right to which those seeking indemnification may be entitled under Section 355.476, RSMo.

Article X Membership Dues

The Membership Dues in SITE Improvement Association shall be established by the Board of Directors.

Article XI Amendments

The Members may repeal or amend these by-laws or any part thereof or adopt new or additional by-laws by two-thirds of the votes cast or a majority of the voting power, whichever is less.

The SITE Advancement Foundation (SAF) was created to receive, hold, administer, and disburse funds for the purpose of promoting and advancing the site improvement construction contracting business within eastern Missouri. More particularly, the Foundation's purpose includes construction employee training (outside of that provided by the union apprenticeship programs); advanced skill and supervisory training; construction technical education; safety education and promotion; accident prevention training; plans and means for improving public and personnel relations; marketing development; standardization of contracts and specifications; job coordination and cooperation between architects, engineers, contractors, sub-contractors and construction owners; collection and distribution of information useful and beneficial to the site improvement contracting industry; and promoting and advancing the interest and common good of the site improvement contracting and construction industry.
