JENNINGS NEW RECREATIONAL CENTER!



The City of Jennings new recreational center began development all the way back in 2022, despite some hiccups along the way, we have retained Navigate Building Solutions as our project manager and Aspire Construction Services as our construction manager and general contractor!

The City of Jennings, Navigate and Aspire broke ground on the new recreational center project on 11/8/2024 and construction began the following Tuesday November 12th, 2024!

The Jennings recreational center project has continued to progress with maximum efficiency, bi-weekly progress meetings have been held to detail actionable items and achieved progress points.

The new recreational center aims to not only be a major source of revenue for the city, but it will also be a hub of well, recreation, of course for the city's beloved residents young and old!

NEW YOUTH AND NEIGHBORS CENTER



The City of Jennings is proud to announce the steady rehabilitation and revamping of one of our city's old firehouses into a renovated and renewed center, focused on the advancement, encouragement, support of safety of our youth

The Jennings Youth and Neighbors Center aims to highlight the importance of the voices and actions of Jennings youth as well as to foster a sense of neighborly cohesion amongst our community's upcoming generations

The Youth and Neighbors Center is currently undergoing intrinsic renovations, starting with the removal of obsolete petroleum tanks

DEMOLITIONS IN THE CITY OF JENNINGS



Derelict and unkempt buildings and structures have been a longtime issue for the City of Jennings, Mayor Johnson has made it a priority to beautify the city, with one major apparatus of change and progress being the demolition of these derelict buildings

So far, 19 city owned properties have been slated for demolition as of July 2024, with Z and L Demolition being contracted for the demolitions as of October 2024

These 19 city-owned property demolitions are slated to begin over the Spring of 2025

GARESCHÉ AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



The City of Jennings has partnered with the St. Louis County Community Development Department to make major improvements to the residential street of Garesché Avenue off Jennings Station Road, using Community Block Development Grant funding from St. Louis County

These will be improvements be for the sake of safety and aesthetic for the area, improving cracked and uneven sidewalks along with giving the avenue a new and distinct flair

The early phases of planning and development are underway for this street improvement project, with monthly progress meetings being held to discuss and determine next steps and actionable items to move towards the construction phase, anticipated for Spring-Summer 2025



CITY OF JENNINGS WARD SPEED BUMP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT/STREET REPAIRS

Residents of the City of Jennings have made their concerns loud and clear on two distinct issues facing our municipality: The issue of speeders and traffic law violators within Jennings and the state of disrepair for a good portion of the City's speed bumps

The City of Jennings aims to replace speed bumps in a state of disrepair and place them in critical areas of speeding law violations throughout the residential wards in the city.

Councilmembers are currently mapping out which speed bumps need to be replaced and where they should be placed to not only combat speeding, yet also prevent further traffic concerns with misplacement, the mapping process is expected to be completed by the end of Spring 2025, with the hiring of a speed bump manufacturer expected in the coming months

These speed bump improvements are expected to have a meaningful impact on the quality of life and travel for Jennings' residents, providing the city with a tool to combat speeding while also protecting resident's vehicles from damage from speed bumps in various states of disrepair

A NEW BASKETBALL COURT ON MARGE AVENUE

A community is nothing without the means for residents, of all ages, to let their hair down and have a little fun! With this principle in mind, Mayor Johnson's administration has made it their mission to provide its residents with all sorts of new ways to play in the City of Jennings! One such thing will be the new basketball court on Marge Avenue

The basketball court on Marge Avenue is expected to provide residents with the opportunity to play safely within a residential community, without having to expend themselves to commute to a basketball court

An invitation for bid will be posted for concrete and fencing vendors within the coming months, with construction anticipated before the end of Summer 2025
